## **Rick Williams Memorial Scholarship**

This Memorial Scholarship was created in memory of Rick Williams. Rick served the community of Santee for 29 years, where he retired as a Fire Captain for the Santee Fire Department. He helped to raise tens of thousands of dollars for cancer research by organizing annual fundraising events on behalf of the Santee Fire Department for Relay for Life. Rick Williams was diagnosed with job related cancer in 2010, where after 8 years; Rick ended his fight with colon cancer on January 28th, 2018. He is survived by his wife and three children.

The Williams family, in partnership with the Santee Firefighters Association, has created an inaugural Rick Williams Memorial Scholarship to ensure that his service and sacrifice will not be forgotten.

## Eligibility

- Be a graduating high school senior or current student at local Junior College in San Diego County.
- Demonstrate plans to attend a 4-year college.
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Son or daughter of San Diego County Firefighter.
